### **BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

Joseph Choate (1832-1917) was a prominent 19<sup>th</sup> century attorney and diplomat. He built the Naumkeag property as a summer home for his family and employed many residents in Stockbridge. Some of the employees included Ralph and Charles Barnes and Robert R. Crighton. Joseph Choate's daughter Mabel Choate (1870-1958) entrusted their summer home at Naumkeag to the Trustees. ### **DESCRIPTION OF THE COLLECTION**

The collection consists of various photographs documenting the lives of the employees of the Choate Family's properties. Majority of photographs are of employees at Naumkeag with a few photographs of employees at Mission House. Many of the employees were connected with the properties for many decades. The collection is organized by the subject of the photographs which include: Early Naumkeag Staff, Farmhouse at Naumkeag, Staff Party, Barnes Wedding, Robert R. Crighton and Unidentified Staff.

Many of the photographs have annotations on the back, some of which are included in this finding aid.
